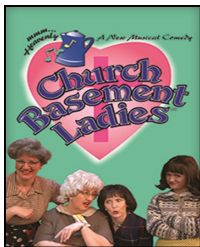

**MAUSTON COMMUNITY SHARING  
FOOD PANTRY NEWS**

If you have not done so yet, please plant a row in your garden for our food pantry clients. Everyone loves shared fresh produce!

With the special needs of the fire families in mind, our special needs for the month of July are: Peanut butter, canned tuna, canned ham, canned chicken and ready to eat canned soups with meat...AND kitchen staples like sugar, flour, baking powder, oil, etc. If you are trying to think of more of these type of items, check your own cupboards for those things you only purchase a few times a year. The pantry is going through a lot of this with the recent fire victims as they get settled into their new homes.

Some of the families are staying in motels or their cars and need easy access food. The pantry is serving them once a week for 3 meals a day for all 7 days each week (or more if needed) to allow them to build up finances to get into a new place and start over. When they are in a new home, the pantry will also be serving them for a few extra weeks to build their cupboards back up.

The pantry also has a "welcome home" bucket available to all these families as well as our regular families who have been homeless. Getting into a new home should be a celebration and everyone really needs cleaning supplies. The pantry gives each family a bucket with a broom, dustpan, mop, toilet bowl brush and cleaner, laundry soap, dish soap, floor cleaner, rubber gloves, SOS pads, paper towels, Windex, Endust and rags.
