Our Lady of Guadalupe Silver Rose Program—A Tradition of the Knights of Columbus since 1960. The Silver Rose program honors the Blessed Virgin under her title of Our Lady of Guadalupe, Patroness of America and Patroness of the Pro-Life movement. The Silver Rose begins its journey in Canada, runs through the United States and terminates at the Basilica of Our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico City, on December 12, on the feast day of Our Lady of Guadalupe. The rose, a symbol of life, was used during the 1960 "Running of the Rose" which ended at the Basilica of our Lady of Guadalupe in Mexico. This flower decomposed after a year. The idea to cast a rose in silver, a precious Mexican metal, was established. The model rose was donated by Mrs. Shirla Ostwowk from a rose bush call "Rose of Peace" which was part of her rose garden.
