FROM OUR PASTOR

January is the opportunity to look ahead, a month to plan for the year. There are a number of activities that are coming up.

For the school we will be celebrating National Catholic Schools Week. That begins on Sunday and runs through the week. Our students can look forward to School Spirit dress up day and student council snacks. The Missions are being highlighted, reminding us of the need to spread and live the Gospel. All week long will be a penny war. Each day something to look forward to.

Also on Sunday the 31st is the Knights of Columbus Free Throw contest. Kids can come anytime from 11 am on with the contest starting at Noon. A fun reason to get out of the house.

This coming week has some feast days that can add to our devotional life. February 2rd is the feast of the Presentation. Traditionally it is called Candlemas. A reminder of the Light entering the temple when baby Jesus is presented according to the law of Moses.

February 3rd is the feast of St. Blaise. Candles are used to offer his blessing for health. I will be visiting the classrooms to offer the blessing of throats to our students and staff.

Friday is First Friday. So we invite everyone to be a part of the time of adoration. It begins at Noon and continues until 6 pm. Life can be hectic so finding some quiet time is important; let alone some face time with Jesus. Stop in, even for a few minutes.

Saturday is First Saturday. So we do have Mass at 8 am that morning for Mass of the day. We recall the Japanese Martyrs and their witness of the faith. Confession will follow the Mass.

We view the saints in many ways. Often it is amazement and the thought that I could never do that. Yet Matthew Kelly in his book, "Rediscover the Saints" offers us another way to look at things.

"We can change the world. What does the world need? It needs holy moments. That's all. The solution is usually simpler than we imagine. History is a collection of holy moments and unholy moments. Our desire to see the world change is a desire to see the holy moments outweigh the unholy.

What is a holy moment? A holy moment is a moment when you make yourself completely available to God. You set self-interest aside, you set aside what you want to do or feel like doing, and for that moment you do exactly what you sense God is calling you to do. The saints were masterful at taking ordinary, everyday events of life and turning them into holy moments." Give it a try!

Perhaps this week we can plan, but not for the whole year, just this week to find or make some "holy moments."
