FROM OUR PASTOR:

Our first week end in Lent. What a great season to see where we are at spiritually. So often people look only at what they will give up. As mentioned before, we should consider how what we are giving up will bring us closer to Jesus. Perhaps it is a habit that needs to change that we need to give up or work on its positive. When we work on something we should also bring it to prayer. In a particular way we need to be specific in our prayer for the positive virtue to overcome a negative we are working on.
