

# February 28, 2021 SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT

#### FROM OUR PASTOR

Happy Lent! Not always the way people approach this season of conversion. Why not be happy? Changing our lives should lead us to seeing the good in our lives and the good we can do. When we make changes it is not usually or intentionally to make ourselves more miserable. So I encourage you to embrace Lent and all that it offers to us so as to become happy.

Matthew Kelly in his book "Rediscover the Saints" tells us " Take time to reflect. Look deeper. Seek out the unseen opportunities that you have overlooked at first glance. Possibilities abound. You and I--human beings--are capable of incredible things.

There will be fabulous joy in the journey, as well as heart-wrenching pain. Anyone who offers you an easy path is to be mistrusted. Life is difficult and messy; there is no point trying to mask that or pretend otherwise. But every situation you encounter is in need of one thing: a holy moment. {remember that point from last month?}

We underestimate ourselves, but God never does. He knows exactly what you are capable of in collaboration with Him. Allow God to raise up the saint in you."

We may not think of ourselves as a saint or saint in the making. Yet if we want to go to heaven (and who doesn't) we are to be saints. Those two goals go together. That should be what we are aiming for. March has some great saints for us to look to for guidance. Obviously our patron St. Patrick. Being kidnapped and sold into slavery did not stop him from being a saint. Or going back and forgiving the person who owned him.

St. Katharine Drexel is a wonderful saint and example to us. How easy it would have been for her to just to enjoy the wealth that she was born into. Yet she saw the need and asked the Pope for missionaries to spread the faith. He told her to become a missionary herself. She did, and founded schools and a University along with a religious order.

Sts. Perpetua and Felicity were martyrs of the early church. St. Perpetua had a very young son that they took from her for a while to change her mind and leave the faith. St. Felicity gave birth to her child days before she was executed. Neither was offered any mercy, which with charity, was a mark of a christian in the ancient world.

March 19th is the solemnity of St. Joseph. He is often called the 'just' man in the scriptures. To be just in the eyes of God says a lot. St. Joseph does not say anything in the Gospels but what he does is follow fully the call of God in his life. He quietly went about caring for Mary and Jesus. We too are called to quietly have Jesus, Mary and Joseph a part of our lives too.

Another great Solemnity in the month of March is the Annunciation. The visit of the angel to Mary is depicted in so many ways in art. Mary responds by saying she is the handmaid of the Lord. We see her humility and yet to be the Lord's instrument is an amazing thing. Perhaps we take it for granted. So for this feast day let us step back and realize what her "yes" means and how we are called to say "yes" to the Lord's call in our own daily lives.


