FROM OUR PASTOR

My dear brothers and sisters, Praise be to the Lord. Thought for Lent 2024: it's time to refresh. In a world filled with personal and structural sin that allows injustice to grow, we are invited to refresh our souls and our imaginations to make space for the Spirit to work through us. To renew trust in abundance versus scarcity so that all people's needs are met while safeguarding a fragile planet. During the Lenten season, Psalm 23 reminds us of God's intent that we find times of refreshing: Beside restful waters he leads me; he refreshes my soul. St. Ignatius of Loyola refers to these times of refreshing as consolations: a deep-seated sense of God's presence leading to spiritual growth. How are we being refreshed and consoled in our lives, in our Church, and in our work for justice?

"How we live our life is far more important than how we say we live our life." This quote is a constant reminder to not just "talk the talk," but also "walk the walk." Am I living in congruence with my values? Do I just say that I stand for justice, but then walk by someone on the street without acknowledging their humanity because I am busy or in a rush? With social media, it is tempting to re-post and re-share messages so everyone knows what we stand for, but are we abiding by those when no one is looking? This is the question that the gospel is evoking for us during this Lent. Are we people who preach important values, but don't practice them? We need to be mindful of the trap of hypocrisy as it can easily creep up on us in our daily lives. Stay refreshed with these values during this Lent.

LENTEN REGULATIONS

Lenten regulations are as follows:

1. Catholics who have celebrated their 14th birthday are to abstain from meat on **Ash Wednesday, all Fridays in Lent, and Good Friday.**
2. In addition to abstaining from meat, Catholics who have celebrated their 18th birthday, until they celebrate their 59th birthday, are to fast on **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday.** Those who are bound to this regulation may eat only one full meal. Two smaller meals are permitted if necessary to maintain strength according to one's needs, but eating solid foods between meals is not permitted.
3. When abstaining from foods or pleasures during Lent, always remember a spirit of detachment. It is in letting go of the things in the world, that we find peace, God, and ourselves re-centered on Jesus Christ.
