FROM OUR PASTOR:

Here we go into the third week of Lent, how is it going for you? Have you done what you hoped to do? Is it moving you closer to Jesus and His will for you on the way to heaven? No matter how far along we are on our journey of faith, we can always stop and consider where we are and where we want to be.

Have we taken the needed time for prayer to move our hearts closer to Jesus' Sacred Heart? Have we been to stations this Lent? Whether with the school kids or before Mass on the week ends? Have we checked out the Bible studies being offered? Of course confession. They are offered each Saturday before Mass and on March 22 we will have our communal penance service at 7 pm.

During March I will be offering through the Marian Catechists a thirty day retreat over the phone to two people who have gone through the formation part of the Marian Catechist program. Which is a good reminder for all of us. Have we gone on a retreat? Or gone on one recently? St. Anthony in Marathon is a great place to go and get away from the busyness of life and be busy with the Lord growing in relationship with Him.

Next week end in Tomah, those preparing for their marriage will be on retreat. I ask that you keep them in prayer. Pray also for the presenters. Also, have you thought about being one of the people assisting others in their journey to married life? Bring that to the Lord and let me know.

Ash Wednesday began with Jesus speaking of prayer, fasting and almsgiving. I offer you the following from the National Conference of Catholic Bishops,"One of the most frequently asked questions is 'how much should I give?"" All Christian stewards must consider prayerfully the gifts they have received from God, and they should make a decision (in advance, from the "first fruits" instead of what is left over after other obligations have been met) about what will be given." Who said Lent is easy? If you have not yet participated in the Annual appeal, this is a good time to do so. Feel free to take one of the purple envelopes in the back of church as a Lenten sacrificial gift.
