He has also served as director of diocesan commissions for youth and regional Catholic television communications in the Tamil language. His last assignment before coming to the Diocese of La Crosse was as parish pastor and Secretary to Prison Ministry. He will be arriving in the parish Thursday, April 8, 2021.

Easter is an exciting time, a time of growth and new life, especially in Christ. As we experience new opportunities may we trust in the Lord and all the gifts that He won for us on the Cross. In the Easter season may we always proclaim that "He is risen, risen indeed. Alleluia!!"

We have collected **\$ 8,119.00** so far.

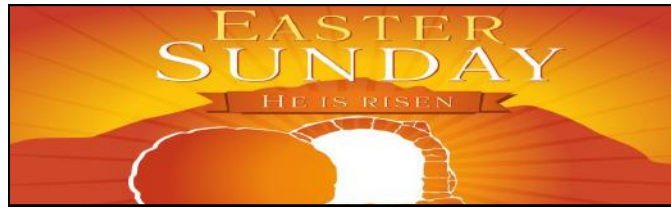

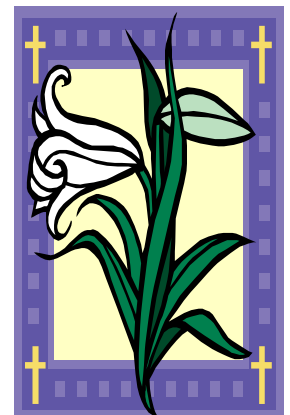
