

April 11, 2021 SECOND SUNDAY OF EASTER (DIVINE MERCY SUNDAY)

FROM OUR PASTOR

Wow, what a week! Celebrating the Holy Triduum is always a great grace. There is so much going on liturgically. The sights and sounds and incense. So much singing, thank you to all who practiced so hard to sing and play the instruments that lifted our hearts to God.

The renewal of baptismal vows and recalling our own baptism with the use of Holy water always brings a smile to my face as I go through church blessing everyone, even those in the balcony.

This whole week (the octave) of Easter is one long day. 24 hours is not enough for us to grasp what God has done for us by His passion, death and resurrection. Then for us to enter the Easter season and reflect with the Sunday readings of that new life won for us on the Cross and how to then apply it to our lives today takes the whole season to do it well.

We conclude the octave with the celebration of Divine Mercy Sunday. What a great feast. I encourage you to research more and find out for yourself the great treasure we have in Divine Mercy. St. Faustina's diary is a big book yet filled with many insights and encouragements. I also encourage you to take part in the devotions that are a part of the day. Even a few minutes of adoration can be a blessing. Of course reciting the Chaplet together on the feast day is a grace. The image will be on display in the front of church to assist you in the requirements for the indulgence that is a part of the day.

As mentioned last week, Fr. Chinnappan arrived on Thursday afternoon. I feel sorry for him as I keep throwing all kinds of new information at him. There are so many new faces and it takes a bit of time to digest all the information. So do welcome him and introduce yourself a few times to him as everyone is new.

As Fr. Chinnappan is here for his first weekend; he will spend his first full week on retreat. So will I for that matter. This week is the annual retreat for the priests of the diocese. St. Anthony Retreat Center is limiting the number of priests who can attend, so many of my brother priests will have to make arrangements at another time. So it is a blessing to gather in the Easter season to soak in the graces of the season and priestly camaraderie. So please keep us in your prayers this week.

You will see in the bulletin that there aren't any Masses here at the parish during the week. Fr. Chinnappn and I will be offering Mass intentions at the retreat center as daily Mass is part of our schedule of prayer.

The annual retreat for us priests is a powerful reminder that we are not the Savior and we need to make that time for more intense prayer entrusting all that we are doing into the hands of our Lord Jesus. I would encourage you to take this time to pray for vocations to the priesthood keeping in mind in a special way, Deacon Eric Mashak who was with us last summer and will be ordained a priest this June.
