FROM OUR PASTOR:

This Sunday, I and my priest group will be going to Milwaukee to St. Francis Seminary. We try each year to get to St. Francis or Mundelein Seminaries to support the seminarians that are there. It has been very good to have Sam with us this year. I have to say that the year has gone by rather quickly. At the morning Mass we read and pray for the seminarian of the day from the vocations booklet. The need for priests does not go away, so I encourage you each day to pray for that intention (and your pastor could use a few prayers too!)

This coming Sunday will be 1st Communion at the 10 am Mass. What a great day for our second graders. I thank Ms. Benz and Mrs. Thayer for all their efforts. Their parents of course have been the biggest influence for their children's preparation to receive Jesus for the first time. I encourage you to consider the manner that we model our own reception of Jesus at Mass. By our actions, do we show them our belief in the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity that is given to us at each Mass?

We are so close to our goal for the Diocesan Annual Appeal. We are reminded that 20% of the appeal goes to the formation of our future priests (like Sam) and future deacons that will serve the diocese and our parishes for years to come. So our annual appeal is really an investment in the future of our local church. 10% goes to Catholic education and at St. Patrick's school last year we benefited by receiving a grant for thousands of dollars that came back to us. In general any amount that goes over our goal comes right back to the parish to be used for parish projects.
