May 6, 2018 SIXTH SUNDAY OF EASTER

Dear Parishioners,

What a joy it has been to be with you all this year! One of my first weekends here was during the Fall Festival, and it seems like that was just the other day. Between now and then I've taught religious education, visited the school, led a Bible study, went to parish meetings, stopped in at the nursing home, made communion calls, and served at many Masses. It's been a busy and rewarding ministry.

In my time at St. Pat's I've found myself with a renewed enthusiasm and joy for the priesthood. I get the sense that I will be stretched for the full duration of my priesthood and that this is entirely compatible with joyfulness and fulfillment. I'm very excited to go back to seminary and share my experience with my brothers there – I have a fresh perspective and I think it will enrich my remaining time in formation and into my life as a priest. Two areas of particular emphasis for me during this year were sharing of my self and taking initiative, and as I reflect on the past months I can see how far I've come in these areas. It comes down to receiving the will of the Father and participating in his self-gift: his will – his life within me – is my 'food and drink' and this allows me to give and never be spent. What a blessing it has been to learn this lesson here at St. Patrick's.

A little bit about my future plans: this summer I'll be in Minneapolis for a hospital chaplaincy program. I'm looking forward to that ministry and also excited to be in the Cities close to friends from college. I will stay with a group of priests, the Companions of Christ, who make a commitment to live and pray in community. At the end of the summer I'll be heading back down to Mundelein Seminary for my final two years there. Diaconate ordination will be in almost exactly a year and priestly ordination will be at the end of June in 2020. I'll be sure to keep you all posted on those dates! My last weekend here at the parish will be May 19th and 20th (though I'll be gone next weekend for a friend's ordination).

Leaving St. Patrick's is bittersweet. I will definitely miss being here and miss the many great people here, but am excited to keep learning and continue the path toward priesthood. Know of my prayers for each of you – I will see you in the Eucharist.
