I look forward to serving and learning from you this summer. Since I am new here, I thought I would share about myself. I grew up in Wittenberg, WI which is a small town between Green Bay and Wausau. My parents raised me and my three brothers in a loving home there. I attended the public high school in town, and it was in my high school years that I first thought of priesthood. God drew me to seminary with strong priestly desires, and I applied for seminary for the Diocese of La Crosse in my senior year of high school.

Seminary usually takes about eight years before ordination: four for philosophy in college and four for theology at a graduate level. I graduated 2017 from St. John Vianney College Seminary, St. Paul, MN with degrees in Philosophy and Classical Languages. A couple weeks ago, I finished my first year of graduate studies in theology at St. Francis de Sales Seminary in Milwaukee. I continue to sense God's call to the priesthood, and the seminary continues to help cultivate me into a holy and loving priest. My assignment at St. Patrick under Fr. Potaczek and the pastoral wisdom here will further that seminary formation.

After teaching several classes and giving talks in seminars, I have grown to love teaching the Faith. Again, thank you for welcoming me, and I look forward to getting to know you and your community.
