FROM OUR PASTOR

Welcome to June Dairy month. Welcome also to Jared Clements (a seminarian of the diocese)! Please take some time to greet him after Mass. He will be with us for the next few weeks. He is in residence before he heads off to language school in preparation for his studies in Rome. These few weeks are meant to give him another view of parish life, even though many things are winding down for the summer, there will be enough to add to his experience and there will be learning opportunities for him.

This coming week will wrap up a number of things for the academic year, taking the summer off until the fall. One of those is the Mauston Area Ministerial Association. The local pastors (most of them) meet once a month to be together and reflect on the needs of the community and build support for the Gospel. This is also the last week for school. With us starting with a flood day and adding a few (!!!) snow and ice days, it has been a long year. So hopefully we have a nice long summer to balance that out.

Looking ahead, I will be part of a retreat up north that starts on June 9 and continues into the late afternoon of June 11. The Institute of St. Joseph is a diocesan public association of the faithful. I will not have to lead the retreat this time, but be there for confessions and some spiritual direction. So please keep all of those on retreat in your prayers during those days.

Retreats and time in prayer and prayer with the scriptures are a good way to listen to what God asks of us. God speaks to us all the time. There are little moments that He wants us to respond to with generosity. There are big moments in our lives that can change directions for us in a radical way. Often that is when people pray; when they have to make big decisions. Yet we are to bring God into all of our decision making. So I encourage you to lift up in prayer all of your daily decisions and ask the Lord to pour out His grace upon your activities.

For those big moments of decision, choosing a vocation for example. That can take a lot of prayer and listening over time. God draws us, attracts us to our vocation, our way of life and service to Him and those around us. It has been many decades since we have had a priestly vocation from our parish to serve the diocese. So please bring that intention to your prayers. To do that I offer the following prayer.

A Prayer for One's Vocation in Life.

Lord, make me a better person: more considerate towards others, more honest with myself, more faithful to you. Help me to find my true vocation in life and grant that through it I may find happiness myself and bring happiness to others. Grant, Lord, that those whom you call to enter priesthood or religious life may have the generosity to answer your call, so that those who need your help may always find it. We ask this through Christ our Lord. Amen.
