THE MOST HOLY BODY AND BLOOD OF CHRIST (CORPUS CHRISTI)

FROM OUR PASTOR:

Dear brothers and sisters in Christ Jesus, Praise be to the Lord. Last May 21st was a wonderful day. 17 of our children received the Holy Spirit during their Confirmation ceremony. The whole event went very well. Our new bishop, Most Rev. Battersby was very happy about children who behaved very well for the whole Mass. Godparents (Sponsors) were excited to accompany their Godchildren during their Confirmation ceremony. I would like to write something about the beauty of being a Godparent. The role of godparents is a high honor given to a man and a woman after the birth of a child.

Godparents are often chosen for their relationship with the Lord and their relationship to the parents of the newborn child. Traditionally a godparent will take part in a baptism and later in a Confirmation, and make a vow to assume a role in the spiritual development of that child. A godparent serves God in developing a close-knit relationship with the child, encouraging through a Christian light whenever possible.

The godparents' <u>purpose</u> is to help the child attain heaven. Pursuant to the law of the Church, a godparent (or *sponsor*) must, in pertinent part, "<u>be a Catholic who has been confirmed and has already received the most holy sacrament of the Eucharist and who leads a life of faith in keeping with the function to be taken on" (Can. 874 §1.3). The role or "function" of godparents cannot be reduced to some social award. The godparents will publicly affirm their commitment to help the parents in their Christian duty to raise the child in accordance with true religion.</u>

The duties of a godparent are simple: be holy so that you may help lead your godchild into holiness. The godparent is a spiritual mentor and should be an exemplar of Catholic virtue in both word and deed. As Pope St. Paul VI warned, the gap between the gospel and the culture is growing. Parents benefit greatly from godparents who will be a light and guide, like the candle lit at baptism, to their child. So, for all godparents and godparents-to-be out there: be intentional. Take seriously the things of God. And may the child, the parents, and you all work together to be holy and attain heaven.

"Walking with Jesus in the Corpus Christi Procession" ~ The annual solemnity of the most holy body and blood of Christ (also called Corpus Christi, "Body of Christ") finds many parishes around the world celebrating a procession in which a host consecrated at Mass is then carried in a monstrance in a solemn way through a city's streets-June 2 in 2024. Like the Blessed Sacrament itself, there is more to the Corpus Christi procession than meets the eye. It is an occasion to profess our faith in the sacrament of the Eucharist, to thank Jesus for the gift of His cross and presence in this sacrament and to walk with Him toward the promised land of heaven. After the 10 AM Mass this weekend, we will have a procession from the church to Riverside Park. We will, then, return to church for adoration until 12:30 PM. We will close with benediction at 12:30. For those who cannot walk to the park, you may wait at the church for the procession to return.


