

June 9, 2019 PENTECOST SUNDAY

FROM OUR PASTOR

"What the world needs is God's love; it needs to encounter Christ and to believe in Him. The Eucharist is thus the source and summit not only of the Church's life, but also of her mission: 'an authentically eucharistic Church is a missionary Church.' We too must be able to tell our brothers and sisters with conviction: 'That which we have seen and heard we proclaim also to you, so that you may have fellowship with us' (1 JN 1:3) Truly, nothing is more beautiful than to know Christ and to make him known to others....We cannot approach the Eucharistic table without being drawn into the mission which, beginning in the the very heart of God, is meant to reach all people." (The Sacrament of Charity sec. 84 Pope Benedict XVI)

June is filled with many activities and once school is done, summer vacation begins for our students and staff. June is also the month of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. A reminder of God's love for us. As noted above, the sacrament of love is the Holy Eucharist. Many in society and perhaps our own family, do not know the love of God. Perhaps it is only an idea that they have heard or phrase that does not have that much impact in their lives.

As the feast of Corpus Christi is approaching us, it is a good reason to step back a moment in our life of faith and ask in our own hearts, when we receive Jesus on Sunday at Mass, do we "hear" God saying 'I love you?'. What is our connection to the very Body and Blood of Jesus during the week? How do we receive Him at Mass? Has that expression of God's love for us become routine? Do we not expect much?

When I offer Jesus, "The Body of Christ" to people at Mass when they come up for communion, perhaps of third of the people say nothing!! What a gift God gives of Himself and there is no response from a concrete expression of God's love for us?!

Corpus Christi is a feast that the Church has been celebrating for centuries. It was an answer to those who doubted the real presence of Jesus. There was a great theological debate that lead to a deeper understanding of this physical expression of the love that God has for His people.

In "Stay with us, Lord" St. John Paul II says "It is significant that the disciples on the road to Emmaus duly prepared by our Lord's words, recognized him at table through the simple gesture of the 'breaking of bread.' When minds are enlightened and hearts are enkindled, signs begin to 'speak.' The Eucharist unfolds in a dynamic context of signs containing a rich and luminous message. Through these signs the mystery in some way opens up before the eyes of the believer." (Sec. 14)

Let us take this time in the month of the Sacred Heart to come to know in a deeper way the love the Father has for us expressed through His Son Jesus and enkindled by the Holy Spirit.
