### FROM OUR PASTOR

Being on retreat last week (Monday and Tuesday) with the Institute of St. Joseph was a great grace. We had time to go into depth on St. Teresa of Avila, Blessed Charles Foucauld, and St. Theresa Margaret of the heart of Jesus. The hidden life of prayer is an area we all need to work on. There really isn't a point we can say that we know Jesus enough!!

St. John Paul in "Stay with us, Lord" reminds us of the way of solidarity. "The Eucharist is not merely an expression of communion in the Church's life; it is also a project of solidarity for all of humanity. In the celebration of the Eucharist the Church constantly renews her awareness of being a 'sign and instrument' not only of intimate union with God but also of the unity of the whole human race. Each Mass, even when celebrated in obscurity or in isolation, always has a universal character. The Christian who takes part in the Eucharist learns to become a promoter of communion, peace and solidarity in every situation. More than ever, our troubled world, which began the new Millennium with the specter of terrorism and the tragedy of war; demands that Christians learn to experience the Eucharist as a great school of peace, forming men and women who, at various levels of responsibility in social, cultural and political life, can become promoters of dialogue and communion." Perhaps that is not what we think of when we receive Jesus each Sunday. That we are on to be agents of peace. Think of all the moments that can be filled with anger, frustration or road rage? How can we bring peace into daily situations? The peace of Jesus and not of the world?

Pope Benedict XVI wrote in "The Sacrament of Charity", "This is why Christian antiquity used the same words, Corpus Christi, to designate Christ's body born of the virgin Mary, his eucharistic body and his ecclesial body." (sec. 15)

The upcoming feast of Corpus Christi draws us more deeply into this mystery of faith. We are united in it and called to come to know what "it" is in the life of faith. This feast reveals it is not a "me and Jesus" kind of thing. We are brought into communion with others by this sacrament. The reality of the Body of Christ takes us beyond what is right before us. We can not hold baby Jesus born of Mary in our arms and rock Him to sleep. We can not see every member of the Church around the world at each Mass. Yet we receive His body and are a part of His Body right here and now.

Thus the need to reflect during the celebration of Corpus Christi on this great mystery. We will have some time at the end of Mass to meditate on the mystery of Jesus' gift to us of Himself; his very body, blood, soul and divinity that we receive under the hidden appearance of simple bread. His real presence is given to us to aid us on the pilgrimage of life. He promised we would not be left alone. He is keeping His side of the promise. Each Mass we go to is not a retreat, but a time of grace. The saints have shown us that they would do anything to receive Jesus, let's join them, and follow their good example.
