# FROM OUR PASTOR

Happy Father's Day! This is one of those days that people can take in many ways. It can be hard if your father has passed. Grieving does not have a time table. There can be divisions in families or distance that has grown over the years. Some do not know their father. Nonetheless it is not just studies that have shown how important fathers are to the development of children, so many have experienced that sense of loss or longing. This is where our heavenly Father comes in. He is the source of "fatherhood" itself. Out of his compassion for His children He has sent His Son to reveal Him more fully to the world.

A powerful example of fatherhood witnessed to us is St. Joseph. He was a man of action. Putting his love into deeds for Mary and Jesus. He has also been there for so many of the saints through his intercession. He is the universal patron of the Catholic Church. Perhaps you noticed that he is mentioned in each Eucharistic prayer at Mass. It is always good to turn to him in prayer and ask his help as he helped Jesus as a young boy and was there for Mary day in and day out in Nazareth. To reach out to him I offer you the following prayer.

Guardian of the holy family, be with us in our trials. May your prayers obtain for us the strength to flee from error and wrestle with the powers of corruption so that in life we may grow in holiness and in death rejoice in the crown of victory. Amen.

Another icon of fatherhood is to be the priest. Sadly that is not always the image that comes to people's mind or experience. So praying for priests is so critical. This last Friday was the solemnity of the Sacred Heart of Jesus. It is a day to pray for priests. We are also looking to June 24th when we will be ordaining 4 new priests for the diocese of La Crosse. So I ask you to pray for and keep in prayer the Deacons Alex Kren, John Zweber, Jared Clements, and Isaac Pecha. They will begin their ministry right after ordination as their assignments have been set.

Promoting vocations to the priesthood is something that we are all called to do. Encouraging the vocation to married life is also something that we may take for granted. Since we grew up in a family we assume that our young people know how to prepare for and live the married life. But we know that families are under a lot of pressure and some have become broken. Our young people truly need to prepare for the vocation to married life. That they can fully enter that sacrament. There is a reason that Jesus raised it to a sacrament and offers grace through it. From the family comes vocations to the priesthood and consecrated life. So turning to St. Joseph and Mary is a good way to support all who look forward to coming together until death do us part. St. Joseph, pray for us.


