Life is a promise, fulfill it. Life is sorrow, overcome it. Life is a song, sing it. Life is a struggle, accept it. Life is a tragedy, confront it. Life is an adventure, dare it. Life is luck, make it. Life is too precious, do not destroy it. Life is life, fight for it.

Be faithful in small things because it is in them that your strength lies.

Your true character is most accurately measured by how you treat those who can do nothing for you.

May you have the time to reflect, to enter prayer not out of routine, but with a longing for God that He has for you. The saints write that to truly pray we need to make time for it. Each time may not be a powerful or mystical experience. Yet giving ourselves that time we can allow for that to happen. In the end, prayer is one friend talking to another, heart to heart. May your prayer time be a time of grace and blessing.
