

June 27, 2021 THIRTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FROM OUR PASTOR

As Bishop Callahan's letter stated "Welcome back to Sunday Mass. The Mass is our intimate encounter with Jesus." What a great invite and reminder to all of us. To encounter the Living God through the Scriptures and the sacrament of the Holy Eucharist. The Mass is that time to be renewed and to rejoice. There is a need for us to gather since we are made in the image of the Holy Trinity, a communion of persons. We are not created to be isolated. Family and friends, including our parish family, are important and necessary for us to fully be who we are called to be. We are to be there to support and challenge each other to grow in the image of Christ.

June 26th is a great day for the diocese as three young men have grown over the last number of years into the image of Jesus the priest. Transitional deacons Eric Mashak, Timothy Reither, and Arturo Vigueras will be ordained to the priesthood for the diocese of La Crosse. Deacon Eric spent last summer with us. He was also a server for me at my last assignment, his family being parishioners there.

Sunday is the Mass of Thanksgiving, their first Mass as the chief celebrant, often referred to as their "first" Mass, which normally occurs at their home parish. Soon to be Fr. Eric Mashak is from St. John the Baptist in Cooks Valley. Family, priests who helped along the way, and friends join him in giving thanks to God for his vocation.

With that in mind, I will be heading up to Cooks Valley immediately after the 10 am Mass on Sunday, car packed and ready to go.

That of course leads me into encouraging you to pray for vocations to the priesthood. It has been over 60 years since St. Patrick's parish has had a young man ordained for service to our local church, the diocese of La Crosse. The world is busy and noisy, so by prayer or a word of encouragement to a young man, take that time to support someone that God is calling to the priesthood.

As priests do not grow on trees, we need to pray for families. Families are busy and stretched and pulled in many directions. Pray that they have the grace to build strong foundations of faith for their children so they can respond generously to God's Call. Moms and Dads need prayers too. I encourage children to pray for their parents, not just to stay up later or get a new phone, but really ask God to bless them to be the best parents they can be. As families grow up they can grow apart, so keep your sisters and brothers in your prayers too.

Vocations to the consecrated life and monastic life are not well understood or as supported as much as the diocesan priest-hood is, since each parish has a priest. But not so many have been to a monastery or have been a part of a ceremony for final yows.

A vocation is God's call. All of us in someway should hear our heavenly Father's voice. He has a plan for each of us, work that only we can do as a married person, priest, consecrated religious or dedicated single person in the world.
