I am Fr. Jeyaseelan Yobu. You can call me "Fr. Jey". I am from India. I was born in September 15, 1976. I grew up in a small town called Kodaikanal, which is located in the hills of Western Ghats of South India. I entered Seminary to study for the Priesthood in the year 1992. I was ordained to the Priesthood in April 18, 2004 for the Archdiocese of Madurai.

Immediately after my ordination, I was appointed as the Personal Secretary and MC to the Archbishop of Madurai. After two years, I was transferred to the diocesan Social Service Centre called, "Madurai Multipurpose Social Service Society (MMSSS)" as the Assistant Director for five years. After five years, I was appointed as the Director of the same concern. During these ten years, my job was to travel all over the diocese to do the works of upliftment and empowerment of the socially and economically disadvantaged people around the Archdiocese of Madurai.

Then in 2015, I was transferred to a Parish called "St. Patrick Church, Periyakulam" as the Pastor. This parish has almost 1150 families and most of them are economically poor. It was a great and wonderful experience to have been working there as a Pastor for almost five years.

Then, as per the request of my Archbishop Most Rev. Antony Pappusamy, I am here now in the diocese of La Crosse to do pastoral ministry for another five years.

I am so excited to be in the Parish of St. Patrick of Mauston. I look forward to saying Mass and addressing the spiritual needs of the people of St. Patrick and to be part of St. Patrick's School.

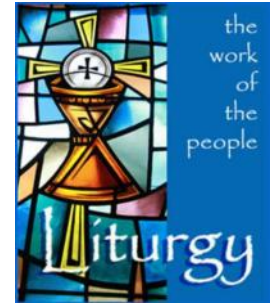

Eucharistic Revival: July 2nd The Eucharist is called the Lord’s Supper

On the night before He was crucified, Jesus had a meal with His Apostles in the Upper Room. It was at this “Last Supper” before He died that He instituted the Holy Eucharist. This was Jesus’ way of remaining with us throughout all time. During supper, Jesus changed the bread and wine into His Body and Blood, saying “*This is My Body which is given for you*” as He will be crucified the next day. “*This cup which is poured out for you is the new covenant in My Blood*” (Luke 22:19b-20). Jesus offered His Body and His Blood on the cross so that we could be adopted into the family of God and live united with Him on earth and forever in Heaven. Let’s pray this right now and every day this week: “*Jesus, thank you for always remaining with us in the Holy Eucharist.*” This week, read how Jesus celebrated the Last Supper in Luke 22:7-20.
