

July 10, 2022 FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARTY TIME

FROM OUR PASTOR

This coming week I will be gone with my priest group. This will be our 20th year at "the cabin". It is a week long time of reflection. Not quite a retreat and not exactly a vacation but time away as a group to enter more deeply into priestly spirituality. There will not be Masses offered here but I am taking Mass intentions with me, so Mass will be said each day for those intentions. In general this time of prayer will encompass all those we serve.

This is also a good time to ask for prayers for priestly vocations. It has been over 60 years since there has been an ordination from St. Patrick's parish. Even when I am in the parish, I can not be everywhere at once. That is the mission/apostolate of all the baptized. To further reflect on bringing the Gospel everywhere I offer the following from St. Paul VI, Apostolicam Actuositatem. This document is one of the fruits of the second Vatican Council. (1965)

"The mission of the Church pertains to the salvation of all, which is to be achieved by belief in Christ and by his grace. The apostolate of the Church and of all its members is primarily designed to manifest Christ's message by words and deeds and to communicate his grace to the world....An apostolate of this kind does not consist only in the witness of one's way of life; a true apostle looks for opportunities to announce Christ by words addressed either to non-believers with a view to leading them to faith, or to the faithful with a view to instructing, strengthening, and encouraging them to a more fervent life. For the charity of Christ impels us (2 Cor. 5:14)

Since in our own time new problems are arising and very serious errors are circulating which tend to undermine the foundations of religion, the moral order, and human society itself, the Church earnestly exhorts [the faithful] to be more diligent in doing what they can to explain, defend, and properly apply Christian principles to the problems of our era in accordance with the mind of the Church....The Church earnestly entreats all the laity in the Lord to answer gladly, nobly, and promptly the more urgent invitation of Christ in this hour and the impulse of the Holy Spirit. Younger persons should feel that this call has been directed to them especially and they should respond to it eagerly and generously. The Lord renews his invitation to all the laity to come closer to him every day, recognizing that what is his is also their own (Phil 2:5), to associate themselves with him in his saving mission. Once again he sends them into every town and place where he will come so that they may show that they are co-workers in the various forms and modes of the one apostolate of the Church....Ever productive as they should be in the work of the Lord, they know that their labor in him is not in vain."

Perhaps that thought could be a point for reflection for all of us. What work of the Lord are we about? As St. Paul VI says age is not the point, by our baptism we are called to make known the Kingdom. Summer vacation seems to be a time we set things aside or let things slide a little. But for the Gospel we are always on to give witness to what we believe and the opportunity to speak of the Good News and its impact on our own lives with those we come in contact with over the summer months.




