 Celebrating its 150th Anniversary March 3, 1868 - 2018

Did You Know?...

I hope you have enjoyed the fun facts about our diocese the last two weeks. Here are some more details from the La Crosse Diocese 150 year anniversary book, Feed My Lambs.

- 11. La Crosse, Green Bay, and Milwaukee were the only dioceses of Wisconsin in 1868.
- 12. Our diocese was therefore much larger, extending to Lake Superior.
- 13. Upon creation, the diocese had 30,000 Catholics and only 18 priests.
- 14. In 1905, Rome created the Diocese of Superior, which redrew the diocesan borders.
- 15. One of those borders moved my parish in Hatley from Green Bay to the La Crosse diocese.

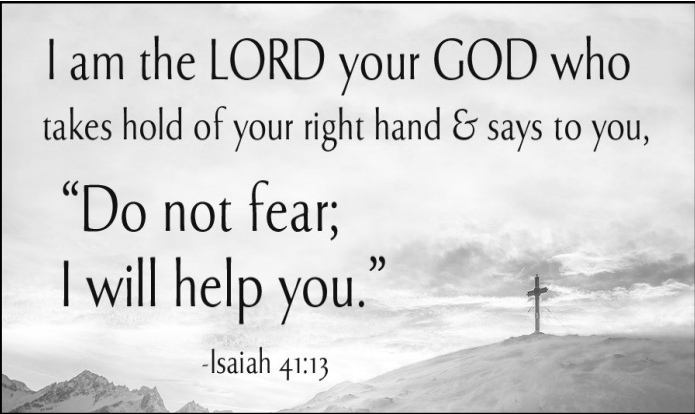
