

July 24, 2022 SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARTY TIME

FROM OUR PASTOR

We know that when we put gas in the car it will take us somewhere. Have we thought about what we put into our head? Where does that take us? What do we listen to? Or watch? Or pay attention to?

Blessed Clelia Merloni, founder of the Congregation of the Apostles of the Sacred Heart of Jesus, offers a thought to reflect on that could challenge us; on what we put into our minds.

"Love your duty; fulfill it joyfully, don't let yourself be overcome by difficulties, failures, monotony, or the length of your work; think that you have the mission of making God loved and of loving him yourself.

Don't worry if sacrifice seems hard to you sometimes; no, what God permits is never too much; and the soul who is generous and who loves perfection must never say "enough." Be generous with Jesus. Never refuse him anything he asks of you, even if it costs your very life.

I bless you and I enclose all of you in the wound of the Sacred Side of Jesus. Warm yourselves in that furnace of pure, holy, and divine love that it may make you holy."

So what are the duties we have in life? Do we simply want a carefree life without responsibilities? Yet Blessed Clelia reminds us that by our baptism we have a mission, a responsibility to make God loved and to love God ourselves. What does that look like? It will of course be different for all of us. In concrete daily ways, how do we go about it? Have we thought about it? Are those the things we ponder on during the day?

What about that call to be generous with Jesus? Do we look at our day in that way? How can I be generous, what can I give to Jesus today? Is that our approach to life? Are we looking for what we can get out of life or what others can do for me?

What about the closing devotional language? Is that something we would say? Or even think? The wounds of Jesus may not be a topic we reflect on often. But we see that commonly in the writings of the saints. The Scriptures and Stations of the Cross remind us that by his wounds we are healed. It is by the passion of the Cross we are freed from sin. By the Cross true and eternal life is made available for us. All of that is done by and through and because of the passionate fire of God's love for us.

At this point of the summer perhaps we don't want to think too deeply but enjoy time with family and friends. Nonetheless we have that mission of making God loved. Who better to start with then those closest to us. Those we care for so much that we want them to get to heaven and experience the furnace of God's love.

Perhaps in those spare moments over the summer, we can look and see, where are we going? Is this the direction I want to go or the spot I want to end up at? What thoughts or information are we putting in our minds to fuel our decisions? Does it lead to holiness or love of God?






