I hope this little update finds you well! I miss St. Pat's and continue to be grateful for my time there.

My summer has been going well: I like Minneapolis/St. Paul a lot and it's been great to spend time with friends up here that I don't otherwise see very often. The majority of my time has been at Abbott Northwestern hospital where I'm a "chaplain intern". I have my own unit that I take particular care of during the week, and on Friday nights plus some weekends I'm on call and I respond to any spiritual needs in the whole hospital (which has sometimes as many as 600 patients). It can be challenging to meet people in times of great suffering and loss, but beautiful to bring the presence of Jesus into those situations. One of my goals has been to grow in my understanding of individuals who experience suffering and step into a greater compassion for them – I want to be able to 'meet them where they're at' just like Our Lord does for each of us.

I finish up in the Twin Cities on August 10 and then have a little time at home before school starts back up at Mundelein on the 19th. Hopefully I'll be able to come visit Mauston some weekend this fall... and I'd be happy to hear from you before then! Know of my thoughts and prayers.

I hope you have enjoyed the last three weeks of facts about our diocese. Here are the last five details I wanted to share with you from Feed My Lambs, the 150 year anniversary book for our diocese.

16. St. Patrick's Parish in Mauston is 11 years older than our diocese.
17. St. Patrick's original church burned down in 1901.
18. Parishioners (and non-Catholics in Mauston) completed the current church in that same year.
19. The current St. Patrick church is the third church for the parish: the former two burned.
20. Throughout the diocese, the earliest parishes had parishioners for their construction crew.
