

# August 13, 2023 NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

## FROM OUR PASTOR

My dear friends in Christ Jesus, Praise be to the Lord. As the Blessing and Opening of our newly renovated is nearing, I am excited to get there into a beautiful church and say Masses in a divine and peaceful atmosphere. I didn't have a chance to look at the church before painting, therefore, the renovated church is going to be a brand new one for me. On August 15, Tuesday, we are going to celebrate the Solemnity of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary. The unique devotion to our Blessed Mother is something beautiful and heart moving in our Catholic Church. Our Blessed Mother always tells us in the Scripture as well as in all her Apparitions, "Listen to Him". We always approach her to intercede for us. When we pray through our Mother, our prayers are answered quickly.

On November 1, 1950, Pope Pius XII defined the Assumption of Mary to be a dogma of faith: "We pronounce, declare and define it to be a divinely revealed dogma that the immaculate Mother of God, the ever Virgin Mary, having completed the course of her earthly life, was assumed body and soul to heavenly glory." The pope proclaimed this dogma only after a broad consultation of bishops, theologians and laity. There were few dissenting voices. What the pope solemnly declared was already a common belief in the Catholic Church. We find homilies on the Assumption going back to the sixth century. In following centuries, the Eastern Churches held steadily to the doctrine, but some authors in the West were hesitant. However by the 13th century there was universal agreement. The feast was celebrated under various names—Commemoration, Dormition, Passing, Assumption—from at least the fifth or sixth century. Today it is celebrated as a solemnity.

Scripture does not give an account of Mary's assumption into heaven. Nevertheless, Revelation 12 speaks of a woman who is caught up in the battle between good and evil. Many see this woman as God's people. Since Mary best embodies the people of both Old and New Testaments, her assumption can be seen as an exemplification of the woman's victory. Furthermore, in 1 Corinthians 15:20, Paul speaks of Christ's resurrection as the first fruits of those who have fallen asleep. Since Mary is closely associated with all the mysteries of Jesus' life, it is not surprising that the Holy Spirit has led the Church to believe in Mary's share in his glorification. So close was she to Jesus on earth, she must be with him body and soul in heaven. In the light of the Assumption of Mary, it is easy to pray her Magnificat (Luke 1:46–55) with new meaning. In her glory she proclaims the greatness of the Lord and finds joy in God her savior. God has done marvels to her and she leads others to recognize God's holiness. She is the lowly handmaid who deeply reverenced her God and has been raised to the heights. From her position of strength, she will help the lowly and the poor find justice on earth, and she will challenge the rich and powerful to distrust wealth and power as a source of happiness.

I wish you all happy feast of the Assumption of Mary, our Blessed Mother. I request you also pray for my native Country India, which celebrates its 76th year of Independence.
