- 4. **Effectiveness:** love cannot stop with mere words but must reflect in our acts. When we come across people who are in need, sweet words or promise of prayers alone will not be any help. We should offer tangible help to fulfill their needs. Otherwise, our love for them is phony.

So let us examine ourselves and see whether the above – mentioned traits of love are there in us or not, let us put into practice these traits of love in our lives and become witness of love.
