FROM OUR PASTOR

I have some good news to share with you. It is part of the fruit from the Diocesan Annual Appeal. There are many programs for vocations and we have been a part of some of them. This coming year we will have a chance to see another part of the program that fosters priestly vocations and is supported by the Annual Appeal.

Joseph Lynch is being assigned to St. Patrick parish as part of the Journey program. Journey is a discerning program before entrance to a seminary that the diocese has developed in response to Vatican requirements. "The Journey program is a nine-month propaedeutic program centered on discernment and initial human and spiritual formation."

"The goal of the parish weekends is to give Joseph a wider experience of parish life and to get an inside perspective of living in a rectory and being with a pastor. Because the men participating in the Journey Program are not seminarians, it is helpful for his discernment to see what a priest does."

So Joseph (and he does go by Joseph) will be here on Saturday and through the Sunday activities then returning to La Crosse for the program's Sunday evening events that he is to participate in. His weekends are once a month in a parish. This is but a piece of the Journey program that helps discernment so he is just "dipping his toe" into parish life.

Please keep priestly vocations in your prayers. In a special way, transitional deacon Samuel McCarty, Steven Weller, and Jared Clements. They have all been at St. Patrick and are taking another step closer to serving as priests for our diocese in the future. In the coming weeks as they are settling into the next step of their program, I would encourage you to write to them a good old fashion letter. Getting some mail when you are far from home is a nice treat.
