TWENTY-NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

FROM OUR PASTOR

There are so many odd things because of Covid after all this time. Try to find something at a store and it is not there--Covid. The mail arrives in 3-12 days in your mailbox--Covid. Businesses are reducing hours because of staffing--Covid. Well the trend continues even with the diocese. Normally I would show you the video and presentation from Bishop Callahan on the Diocesan Annual Appeal. But not this year--Covid. Which sounds pretty strange, but there it is.

So a few things in a nutshell. The theme for the year is "That they may be one as we are one." John 17:22. Bishop Callahan sees as we all do the divisions around us and on so many different levels. Unity is a great sign of God, especially ours as Father, Son and Holy Spirit--one God. The annual appeal is our chance together to support the work of the diocese which is our work.

The Annual Appeal supports a number of great works that build up the Body of Christ here in the La Crosse diocese. I wish to highlight just a few of them.

We have had seminarians with us as a parish the last few years and seen that Frs. Sam McCarty and Eric Mashak were ordained to the priesthood. There are 20 men in some steps of formation. The Appeal supports them with the needed resources to continue that journey of discernment.

My good friend Fr. Pace is the Vicar for Clergy and keeps an eye on 86 diocesan priests, 31 International Priests and 28 Senior priests. His office provides support in many ways like continuing education, retreats and ongoing conferences.

The Office for Deacons supports 55 current deacons for our diocese. There are 23 men in formation to be ordained deacons in the coming years. Deacon Juan has served us for so many years, I know that I am grateful for all he has done. {FYI he is heading up the Mercy hour of prayer on Tuesdays}. Looking down the road for our parish, who else will step up to the call of being a deacon?

The Office for Marriage and Family Life notes that there were 450 couples married this past year in the diocese. They have been helped by many of the support programs that deaneries or parishes offer to help couples to better say "I do" to each other with the help of the Holy Spirit.

More behind the scenes in a way is the televised Mass that is offered each Sunday. There are a number of things needed so that this ministry is there for shut-ins who would not have any other way of praying the Mass that is celebrated in our diocese.

The Diocesan Center in La Crosse is supported by the Annual Appeal. This building was built by Bishop Tracey and has had many uses over the decades. I know I have been to more meetings there than I can count. But any such facility over the years needs maintenance and it is kept up rather well but there are always projects every year that need our support.

There is more, but you can check out greater details on the diocesan website. I simply ask that when you get your letter pray about how you can "be one" with others in the work of the diocese.
