FROM OUR PASTOR:

From the Order of Christian Funerals we have the following prayer:

"God of all consolation, open our hearts to your Word, so that, listening to it, we may comfort one another, finding light in time of darkness and faith in time of doubt."

November is the month given to the Holy Souls. Those who have gone before us and are in need of our prayers. You can google prayers for visiting a cemetery and praying for the dead. Often a Mass is said for deceased members of our families as a way of helping them attain the peace of heaven. The saints can also help us in this area.

The following prayer to St. Joseph is for a happy death. "O Blessed Joseph, who died in the arms of Jesus and Mary, obtain for me, I beseech you, the grace of a happy death. In that hour of dread and anguish, assist me by your presence, and protect me by your power against the enemies of my salvation. Into your sacred hands, living and dying, Jesus, Mary, Joseph, I commend my soul. Amen."

Of course November is not meant to be morbid. Nonetheless we all face death; those around us and one day our own. So being prepared for that day is part of our spiritual journey. The hope of the resurrection gives us needed courage as death seems so overwhelming. With great illness or death so close for other reasons, I encourage you to contact me for the Anointing of the Sick. The idea of "Last Rites" to be given at the "last" moment robs many of the graces of the sacrament. This simple anointing offers grace at a difficult moment. It can be given many times if an illness is long and protracted with obvious times of decline.

On a different note, the Bishop has asked for prayers. The conference of Bishops for the United States will be meeting next week. They have much to talk about and Bishop Callahan is asking that they are kept in prayer. Ask the Holy Spirit for the gift of wisdom for all of our shepherds.
