**Happy Thanksgiving!** Please enjoy time with family and friends and count your blessings. On December 1st, we will welcome Fr. Cryton Outschoorn to our parish. He will be jumping right in so please greet him and make him feel at home.

As we have been reflecting on those who have gone before us, we now take the following point from page 11 of the pastoral letter "On the Christian burial of the Dead."

"The time of death is usually heavy with emotion and can also be confusing for those who have been close to the deceased. It is important that those making the funeral arrangements have immediately the assistance of the priest and other parish ministers in planning well the funeral rites, in accord with the Church's teaching and practice.

Sometimes there is a question about the church from which the deceased is to be buried. Usually, the parish church of the deceased is chosen. (Cf. Can. 1177#1) A member of the faithful has the right, however, to be buried from any church, a right which should always be respected. (Cf. Can. 1177#2) Often, when a person is elderly and has lived away from his or her home parish for a number of years, the choice is made to return to the home parish for the rites of Christian burial, even though the deceased person may no longer be known in the parish. The parish priest and all the faithful of the parish should always welcome the opportunity to provide the funeral rites, whether the deceased is personally known to the parish priest or not."

As we are more than half way through the month of November please continue to pray for all those who have gone before us marked with the sign of faith. Also let us not forget those who mourn. Pray for them and be there for them as grief has no timeline and certain days and seasons can be more difficult as they recall loved ones who are not with them.

Please offer the Prayer for the Holy Souls in Purgatory by St. Gertrude the Great:

Eternal Father, I offer You the most precious blood of thy Divine Son, Jesus, in union with the Masses said throughout the world today, for all the Holy Souls in Purgatory, for sinners in the universal Church, for those in my own home, and in my family. Amen.
