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<u>Madonna alumni to ride on Honor Flight September 1 6</u>

Cousins Patrick F. and Thomas W. Walsh, along with John (Billy) Crowley, all Vietnam Vets, will be passengers on the September 16, 2023 Honor Flight to Washington D.C. The Honor Flight is a nonprofit organization that arranges flights to Washington D.C. for our military veterans to see the monuments built to commemorate their service. The brave men and women selected to be on each flight are allowed to take a family member along with them and are taken to tour the war memorials at the capital. On their return flight they have mail call, at which point letters written to them by their friends and family members are handed out to each veteran.

Pat Walsh was an Army Sgt from 1965-1968 and an Air Force Master Sgt from 1986 till his retirement in 2006. Tom was in the 101st Airborn Division 327 Infantry 2nd Battalion Specialist 4th class at the time of his honorable discharge in 1972. "Billy" Crowley was in the Marine Corp. 1st Division from 1967-1969. All three men returned to Mauston after their tours of duty.

We would like to thank these 3 men, and all of our small town's military veterans for their courage and sacrifice.
