

ASSUMPTION OF MARY HISTORY

The Observance of the Assumption of Mary is a significant event in the Christian calendar, particularly for those of the Roman Catholic, Eastern Orthodox, and Eastern Catholic faiths. The Assumption of Mary is observed annually on August 15th.



This holy day commemorates the belief that the bodily and spiritual ascension of the Virgin Mary into heaven occurred at

the end of her earthly life. Often seen as a celebration of Mary's close relationship with God and her role as a powerful intercessor for the faithful, this occasion also emphasizes the resurrection of the body and the eternal life promised to those who follow Christ.

In the United States, the Assumption of Mary has a rich history that dates back to the earliest European settlers. Both Spanish and French Catholics established missions and communities that honored the Virgin Mary, and as the country grew, so did the devotion to this aspect of their faith. Celebrating the Assumption of Mary serves as a reminder of the cultural heritage, spiritual beliefs, and connection to a larger global community of faith



The Observance of the Assumption of Mary in America can take many forms, from formal masses and liturgical services to processions and community gatherings. In some parts of the U.S., such as Chicago, elaborate feasts and processions are held within Italian, Portuguese, and Polish neighborhoods to honor the occasion. On this special day, let us sing or Listen to a rendition of "Ave Maria". One of the more popular renditions is by Luciano Pavarotti.


