On November 1st All Saint's Day, we celebrate all the Saints in heaven who are our hope and help and inspiration. The rest of the month, we focus on the holy souls in purgatory. (They are also called poor souls because they are suffering, and "holy" because they will definitely get to heaven some day, it's just a matter of time.) We pray especially for the souls of our family members who have died, and aren't quite in heaven yet, but will get there with our assistance. As Catholics, we believe that our prayers and sacrifices offered to God can help the souls in purgatory to get to heaven. It is something very real and important that even little kids can do! Here are some ways to help you get started in this month of November:

- Obtain a plenary indulgence for the souls in Purgatory. One way to do this is to visit
 a cemetery and pray for the dead during the Octave of All Saints' Day, which is Nov.
 1-8. This indulgence has been extended to include the whole month of November
- 2. Another way to obtain a plenary indulgence is connected to the Feast of All Souls' Day on Nov. 2, and can be received by those who piously visit a church or oratory on that day and recite the Our Father and the Creed. *This indulgence has been extended to include the whole month of November*

**These 2 actions are just part of the steps that are needed to obtain an indulgence. You must fulfill the ordinary conditions of an indulgence, which are sacramental confession, reception of the Eucharist, and prayer for the intentions of the pope. Sacramental confession and reception of the Eucharist can occur within a week of the indulgenced act.
